



Frequently Asked Questions

You say it's "free", but really...how much does it cost? What's the catch?

There is NO catch! SiteRx is completely FREE to partner with. Clinical trials are desperate for patients who are a good fit and the companies that run them know a solution like ours can save time in getting new treatment options to market years sooner. They pay us a fee to connect them with doctor-approved patients and we pay great doctors like you to use our platform. Win-win!

Your software integrates into my EHR...what information are you able to see? What do you do with this information? Is SiteRx HIPAA-compliant?

We understand that patient information is very sensitive and SiteRx is committed to the highest security standards. Think of SiteRx as an employee of your office. Our software runs in the background of your EHR, but all PHI is encrypted giving us only information pertinent to matching a patient to inclusion/exclusion criteria for trials in your area. Once a match is found, you are prompted to approve or reject the referral, keeping you in complete control of who is contacted and when. We never access identifying information or contact any patient without your approval and permission to coordinate enrollment. Importantly your data is never sold or transferred to a third party.

What role do I have to play in the trial? Is there a lot of work involved?

SiteRx's mission is to empower physicians to find a cure for neurodegenerative disease. Our goal is to streamline the process of doctors referring patients to clinical trials while integrating into your existing workflow. There is no more work required on your part than a click of one button. You will be able to track your patients' progress within the trial at your convenience, but do not need to participate in any way beyond your typical continuity of care.

What liability issues could I run into?

Using SiteRx will expose you to zero additional liability as a practice. Prior to engaging with any of your patients, SiteRx receives signed consent to participate in research.

Is the payment legal? How does this comply with the Stark Law and the Anti-kickback statute?

SiteRx operates independently from CMS. All payments are administered outside the framework of Medicare reimbursement and we have commissioned a third-party Fair Market Value assessment from [SullivanCotter](#) that confirms the fair and legal nature of SiteRx payments to physicians.
